Immaculate Conception Church February 9, 2025


After he had finished speaking, he said to Simon, "Put out into deep water and lower your nets for a catch." Simon said in reply, "Master, we have worked hard all night and have caught nothing, but at your command I will lower the nets." When they had done this, they caught a great number of fish and their nets were tearing. Luke 5:4–6

Jesus had just cured Simon Peter's mother-in-law as one of His first miracles. As a result of this and other miracles, Peter's entire hometown of Capernaum, as well as many of the surrounding towns, were quickly coming to faith in Jesus. Today's Gospel takes place during this initial excitement over our Lord. In it, Jesus personally invites Peter to become an Apostle, promising to make him a fisher of men. There is much symbolism in this passage worth pondering. First, notice that Jesus uses something very familiar to Peter to invite Him to become one of the Twelve Apostles. He used his trade of fishing.



Another symbolic action Jesus uses is that of putting out "into deep water." It was not enough to simply go a short distance from shore. Instead, the deep water was to symbolize the fact that the Gospel was to go forth to the ends of the earth, just as the fishermen were to fish in the depths of the sea.

Finally, the fact that they "caught a great number of fish" symbolizes the superabundance that would come forth through Peter's apostolic ministry. And the fact that the "nets were tearing" points to the fullness that everyone will experience when they embark upon the mission of Christ. mycatholiclife.com



On February 11, the Catholic Church celebrates the liturgical memorial of Our Lady of Lourdes, recalling a series of 18 appearances that the Blessed Virgin Mary made to a 14-year-old French peasant girl, Saint Bernadette Soubirous.

The Marian apparitions began February 11, 1858, ended July 16 that year and received the local bishop's approval after a four-year inquiry.

Coming soon after the 1854 dogmatic definition of her Immaculate Conception, the Virgin Mary's appearances at Lourdes turned the town into a popular travel destination. Thousands of people say their medical conditions have been cured through pilgrimage, prayer and the water flowing from a spring to which Bernadette was directed by the Blessed Virgin. Experts have verified 69 cases of miraculous healing at Lourdes since 1862. EWTN



As Catholics, each month of the year carries a particular spiritual theme to help us grow in faith and draw closer to God. February is traditionally dedicated to the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph. This focus invites us to reflect on the sanctity of family life and the virtues modeled by the Holy Family in their daily lives.

The dedication of February to the Holy Family grew out of the Church's emphasis on family as the "domestic church." While this devotion gained prominence in the 19th century, its roots stretch back to the earliest Catholic's that venerated the hidden yet holy lives of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph.

HIGH SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

New Scholarship Opportunity - The Nativity of Mary - This scholarship provides a four-year \$2,000 per year scholarship to any rising 9th grade student (current 8th grader) who will attend a Catholic High School in the 2025-2026 school year. The link to apply for the Nativity of Mary Scholarship can be found at https://catholic-foundation.org/grants/scholarships/the-nativity-of-mary-scholarship/.

The Nativity of Mary Scholarship was established for the propagation of the Catholic faith and devotion to Our Blessed Mother. A letter of recommendation, a short essay on the applicant's devotion to our Blessed Mother, and financial need will be used to evaluate the potential applicants. Provided the student remains in good standing and continues to attend a Catholic high school in the Diocese of Columbus, the scholarship will be renewed all four years until that student graduates.

New Scholarship Opportunity - The Hands and Feet of Christ Scholarship - This scholarship provides a \$800 scholarship to a student who will attend a Catholic High School in the 2025-2026 school year at any grade level. The link to apply for the Hands and Feet of Christ Scholarship can be found at https://catholic-foundation.org/grants/scholarships/the-hands-and-feet-of-christ-scholarship/.

A letter of recommendation from a community leader (clergy, youth minister, teacher, etc.) attesting to the applicant's active involvement in his or her own Catholic faith formation and demonstrates financial need (via FACTS Tuition Assistance) will be used to evaluate the potential applicants. This is a single year scholarship.
